RADAR Update: Extended use and flexible payment options

Karlsruhe, February 14th 2025 — Good news just in time for the international Love Data Week: RADAR, FIZ Karlsruhe's research data repository, is opening up to an international user community. Soon, institutions outside Germany will also be able to easily offer their own institutional repository in the cloud. In addition, users from other publicly funded institutions will also have the opportunity to use RADAR for data archiving and publication. As a further option, RADAR has recently started offering a pre-payment option.

RADAR will thus be available to a wider range of user institutions: in addition to publicly funded universities, colleges and research institutions, public or publicly funded museums, libraries, archives and memorials in Germany, the EU, Switzerland and the UK can also use the service. Until now, the RADAR Cloud and RADAR Hybrid services were limited to publicly funded research institutions and universities in Germany.

Appropriately enough, we can announce this news during <u>Love Data Week</u> - an international week of action dedicated to research data and research data management. Data archiving and publication at RADAR follow the FAIR principles (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Reusable) – for to really love data means to keep them findable, usable, and interpretable!
